

WONDERING HOW IT WORKS?

Your existing library card can now be used at any library throughout the Territory. It's business as usual, but with ten times the resources on offer!

We've anticipated some of your questions which will help you understand the new system.



Q What are the benefits of Connect NT?

A Connect NT is perfect when you work, live or travel in the NT. Multiple cards will be a thing of the past and you only need to join once. You will now have access to all the resources held by every public library in the NT network.

Q Will all libraries offer the same services as each other?

A No. Each library may offer different services. Lending periods and overdue policies for items you borrow will depend on which library issues them. Check with your local library.

Q What if I already have multiple library cards?

A As part of Connect NT, you only need one membership. Decide which library you use the most and keep that library card. Please return excess cards to your library.

Q I have billed items at one library. Does this mean I won't be able to borrow from any other libraries?

A Yes. As you have one membership, any overdue or billed items will need to be resolved at the issuing library before you can borrow from another library.

Q Can I return my items to any library in the Connect NT network?

A No. All items must be returned to the library service from which they were issued at your own expense. City of Darwin Libraries (Darwin City, Casuarina, Karama and Nightcliff) are one Library service and items issued from these four libraries can be returned to any of the four.
